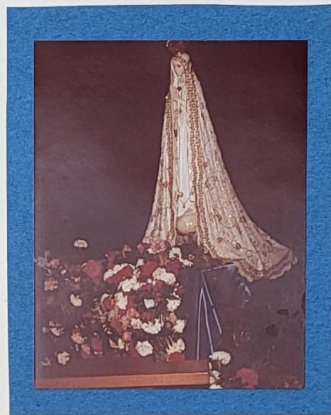

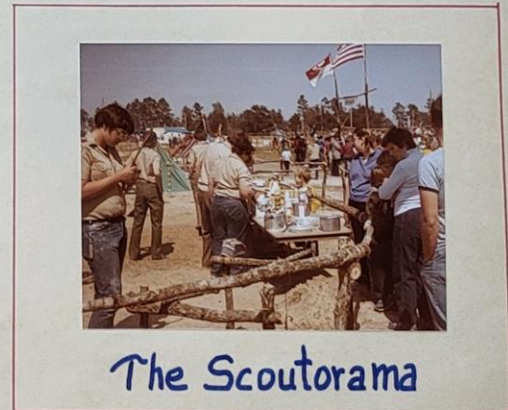

Knights donate \$8,500 to ARC to buy materials

The Knights of Columbus Council 4444 of Fort Walton Beach and Council 2667 of Niceville recently presented the Association for Retarded Citizens of Okaloosa County a check for \$8,500. The amount donated by Council 4444 was \$7,500.07 and by Council 2667 was \$934.93.

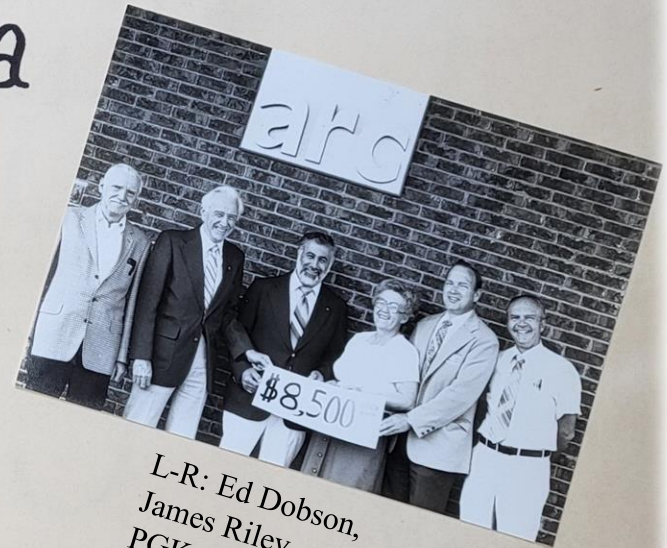
The money will be used by the ARC to buy a cable routing machine and work benches for the Miracle Strip Industries project which is an adult work program conducted by ARC. MSI bids on small government contracts.

The Knights of Columbus conducts an annual Tootsie Roll drive nationally in the month of March to benefit the retarded citizens by collecting donations at front of businesses and on street corners.

The \$8,500 donated this year to ARC is almost twice the amount collected by Council 4444 and 2667 in Fort Walton Beach and Niceville areas. The rest of the money was donated by the Florida State Council of the Knights of Columbus. Because of the exciting programs conducted by the Okaloosa County ARC, the Florida State Council chose to give the extra money required to make the Miracle Strip Industries project successful.
